Here are the steps (according to information provided by the league):

Step 1:

Go to <http://www.ticketreserve.com> and click on **Register Now** in the upper-right hand corner.

Step 2:

Fill out all necessary fields, enter the promo code (**UFLBIRM**) in the promo code field, click submit and then check your email to validate your account.

Step 3:

To see your free FanFORWARD reservation, login at TicketRESERVE, click the My TicketRESERVE tab and check your **Holdings**.

Step 4:

If your city is chosen for the 2008 UFL season, your reservation goes towards the cost of your 2008 season ticket.
