There had been [reports circulating saying that the league would be folding](#) before it even started. Birmingham-based [Team Alabama](#) was scheduled to open its training camp on Wednesday and its season in mid-April and [according to a Birmingham News blog post](#) was not aware of the league's consideration of postponing its inaugural season for a second time.
