

[Legion Field](#) will host the second session of national tryouts for the upstart [All American Football League](#) (AAFL) on Thursday, July 26. [According to their press release](#), more than 200 are expected to take part, including at least 36 former Alabama and Auburn graduates.

Tryouts will begin at 1 p.m. on Thursday with the Old Gray Lady's gates being open to the public beginning at 4 p.m. There will be additional tryouts held in Michigan and Texas during August.
